The Bear of Orogen 《鄂伦春的熊》

Author: Gerelchimeg Blackcrane Illustrator: Jiu'er Reading age: 4-8 years old

This picture book was the second work cooperated by the nature literature writer Gerelchimeg Blackcrane and the illustrator Jiu'er after The Moose of Ewenki (《鄂温克的驼鹿》). Based on the vast Daxinganling forest in northern China, this book shows the simple natural concept that Oroqen people and everything in the forest are sharing the forest, and discusses the harmonious coexistence between man and nature.

Magic Canvas 《雨露麻》

Magic Canvas has won the Fiction Special Mention Award for BolognaRagazzi Award 2021. It is a picture book suitable for children aged 4 and above, and tells the story of a girl Yulu, who loves painting, and a famous illustrator's canvas, the Yulu Linen. At first, every picture the girl drew was melted by the canvas. She drew one picture after another, but it was never accepted by the canvas. After a lost-and-found experience, the girl finally got the recognition of the canvas, and a beautiful self-portrait was presented on the canvas. Through the conflict between the girl and the canvas, this book realizes the inner self-breakthrough of the talented painter. Only when you really enjoy painting can you draw the most beautiful self-portrait.

#### The Iron Hoop Brothers 《铁环兄弟》

The Iron Hoop Brothers was cooperated by Cao Wenxuan, the winner of Hans Christian Andersen International Award, and Iwona Chmielewska, a reknown Polish illustrator. The book takes a pair of iron hoops as the protagonists, telling the story of what they saw and heard during their wandering, including an old man who picked up rags, a little girl who got lost and an old man who was an entertainer. The iron hoop brothers are wandering season by season. This book reveals the changeable human feelings and the fickleness of life, discussing the life problems of meeting and letting go. The illustrator explains the sadness and liveliness of the

hoop with proficient oriental aesthetics, making this philosophical picture book easily arouse deep thinking.

## Cow and Cicada

Who would have thought that a little cicada could save a stubborn old cow? Who would have thought that they would have a lifelong friendship? Anyway, from that day on, the old cow and the cicada were so wonderfully connected. Cicada often rests on the apple tree, but more often, it will land on the corner or back of the old cow and accompany the old cow to the grassland by the river. They spent all their time together until the cicada had to leave this world... The old cow promised to look after the cicada's children. After the larvae burrowed into the ground, the old cow guarded the apple tree day and night, year after year. One night, the cicada finally got out of the ground and climbed up the apple tree one by one. The old cow looked at them, amazed, and couldn't get enough of them. But one day, his eyes closed. Maybe he has fallen asleep. Or he is already on his way to heaven, looking for his cicada.

#### Dawu's Fantasy Trilogy "奇幻日常三部曲"系列

This series contains three volumes: Absolutely Do Not Let an Elephant Walk into Your Room (《千万别让大象走讲 房间》), Never Help a Snail (《不要移动一只蜗牛》), and The Magic Carpet (《神奇飞毯》). In Absolutely Do Not Let an Elephant Walk into Your Room, the elephant is actually a metaphor for unresolved conflicts between Dawu and his brother: the bigger the elephant grows, the greater the damage to the life of the two brothers ... In Never Help a Snail, Dawu, the author, helps a snail out of kindness, but unexpectedly it was caught by a bird. The story then follows two parallel narratives, one telling Dawu's frustration at his good intentions and devil deeds, while the other telling the snail's experience after being caught by the bird. The two lines were influencing each other without the characters realizing it. In The Magic Carpet, the elder brother gets a magic flying carpet that can fly in the air. Dawu, the puppy, the kitten, the bird and the butterfly want to take a ride with elder brother in turn. Eventually, the carpet is overwhelmed, falling down to the ground and being torn. But Dawu thought of a good way to make everyone fly into the sky again ... This series tells three interesting and philosophical,

stories for children, presenting a fantastic daily life that helps children enrich their horizon.

Chinese Classic Folklore Picture Book Series is a set of folk literature picture books created for modern children, including five volumes: The Magic Cloth Made by One Hundred Birds' Feather, The Amazing Zhuang Brocade, The Secret of the Long-haired Girl, The Adventure on the Third Day of *March*(《一起来过三月三》), and *Bagu and Sacred Elephant* Mountain (《巴咕与神象山》).

This set of books utilizes diverse artistic techniques to retell classic stories from children's perspective. The theme is rooted in tradition and full of new ideas and imagination. The Magic Cloth Made by One Hundred Birds' Feather tells the growth story of a brave ranger boy fighting for the lives of one hundred birds. The Secret of the Long-haired Girl appeals to everyone to protect the water and talks about how children keep secrets in a poetic way. The Amazina Zhuang Brocade tells the story of a hardworking woman who is very good at weaving. She pursues her dreams and weaves the most beautiful brocade in the world. The Adventure on the Third Day of March tells the story of four children's adventures on the third day of March. In Bagu, and Sacred Elephant Mountain, children and elephants guard their natural homes.

Five artists draw illustrations with various materials, such as ink acrylic, gouache, crayon, colored chalk and woodcut painting. Drawing on the artistic style of Dunhuang frescoes and rock paintings, the illustrators have brought readers the aesthetic experience and led them to appreciate the diverse beauty of folk culture and painting art.
