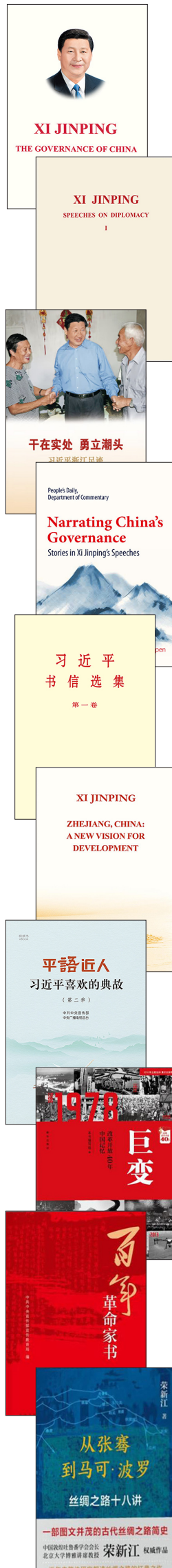

This book collects 100 family letters which were written by the martyrs who sacrificed their lives since the New Democratic Revolution in 1919. These letters were collected by more than 20 cultural organizations, including the National Museum of China and the Military Museum of the Chinese People's Revolution. The book is compiled chronologically from 1921 to 2018 according to the time of those letters. Many of these martyrs laid down their lives for the independence and liberation of the Chinese nation, whilst other heroes were model workers during the construction of New China.

Authored by Rong Xinjiang, president of the Dunhuang Turfan Society of China and a historian of Peking University, the book is a brief account of the Silk Road's history. Using rare historical documents, latest archaeological findings and authoritative scientific research results collected from home and abroad, the book makes in-depth analysis of 18 issues about the Silk Road, including its courses, towns along the routes, wars and trade, human migrations, and changes in political regimes and settlements, expounding the Road's historical role in promoting exchanges and mutual learning between Chinese and foreign civilizations. The book was selected into the national key publication project of the 13th Five-Year Plan.
