
Never Helps a Snail

About Bioethics – A Review on *The Bears of Orogen*

The Bears of Oroqen was created by Gerelchimeg Blackcrane and Jiu'er, the same team of The Moose of Ewenki. When I was studying The Moose of Ewenki, I found that, as a Chinese original picture book, it surprisingly won two American awards: one is 2019 Freeman Book Award, and the other is 2020 Aesop Accolades. The former mainly rewards outstanding children's books that have contributed to the culture of East and Southeast Asia, while the latter rewards

outstanding works that highlight folk culture. I think the recognition of these two awards shows the importance of reading in broadening the deep understanding of human civilization. We see the life of Ewenki and Oroqen people in picture books, not for curiosity, but because their life is also part of the whole life of mankind, and their gathering and hunting lifestyle also come from our ancient ancestors. Knowing them is actually knowing ourselves.

The story of The Bears of Oroqen is that the hunter burned a mattress that mother bear and cubs liked very much. To be honest, I didn't quite understand the old hunter's intentions when I first read it. When I tried to tell this story to the adults and children around me, few of them could understand why at once. I think this just proves why we especially need such a book, which gives us an



opportunity to re-understand the relationship between human beings, wildlife and nature, and try to explore the prevailing bioethics. This ethics not only deals with the relationship between people, but also regards the whole earth as a home and discusses the bioethics that every member should hold in the whole home (that is, the ecosystem).

The prologue before the core plot is very long but beautiful, which reminds me of the book Owl Moon.

Although it is long, I think it is helpful to understand the core plot. Aya, a girl, followed her grandfather to see the bears. In fact, she took the reader to appreciate this beautiful home and try to stand on the position of all beings, not just human beings.

Reading The Bears of Oroqen reminds me of a paragraph by Albert Schweitzer in Die Ehrfurcht Vor Dem Leben:

It makes only the maintenance and promotion of life rank as good. All destruction of and injury to life, under whatever circumstances, should be condemned as evil. True, we are forced to make choices in real life. At times we have to decide arbitrarily which forms of life, and even which particular individuals, we shall save, and which we shall destroy. But the principle of reverence for life is nonetheless universal and absolute
